JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assess patients, provide preventative care, physical exam, orders and analyzes lab studies. Use microscope as indicated for diagnosis of infection
- Insert and remove IUD per District 2 protocols and guidelines
- Develop plan of care with careful interpretation of lab studies, health history and physical exam
- Provides treatment per protocols, administers medications/vaccines per protocol and guidelines. Verifies immunization status of teens (11 years through 19 years). Reviews immunization record with teen
- Provides health education and instruction for promotion and maintenance of health.
- Appropriate plan of contraception implemented after obtaining health history, physical exam and lab studies as indicated per District 2 protocols and guidelines
- Provides care to pregnant women during the ante partum and post partum periods per District 2 protocols and guidelines
- Serves as a preceptor for new staff, assist with cross training staff in Women's Health and is a preceptor for Nurse Practitioner students when clinic permits

- Maintains and updates professional knowledge and skills through participation in short courses/workshops and provides information and instruction to subordinate employees
- Obtains working knowledge of all clinics
- Assists with staffing and scheduling of patients

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Doctorate or Master's degree in Nursing from an accredited college or university and/or other education requirements approved by the Georgia Board of Nursing AND Certification in the specialty area(s) approved by Georgia Board of Nursing AND Two years PH experience AND Georgia license as a Registered Professional Nurse AND Georgia License as a APRN AND Current certification in specialty area AND CPR certification.
