Avoid the rush. Get your back-to-school vaccines now.

GAINESVILLE, GA – Hall County Health Department reminds all parents that now is a good time to get those required school vaccinations. With vacations and busy summer activity schedules, it can be easy to forget about school and getting ready for a new year.

Kids need pencils, paper and other supplies for school. Just as important, kids need to be up-to-date on their shots. Children entering kindergarten, middle school and high school are required to have certain vaccinations.

To help make sure that all children are up-to-date, Hall County Health Department will be giving school immunizations on these dates:

July 5 – 29: Normal Operating Hours*

Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday:	8:00 am to 4:00 pm
Tuesday:	8:00 am to 6:00 pm
Friday:	8:00 am to 2:00 pm

(Closed for lunch each day from Noon to 1:00 pm)

August 1 – 12: Special Clinic Hours*

Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday:	8:00 am to 4:00 pm
Tuesday:	8:00 am to 6:00 pm
Friday:	8:00 am to 2:00 pm

(Open through lunch each day for shots)
