JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:

Under broad supervision, provide professional nursing care in accordance with nurse protocols, policies and/or procedures. Focus on the prevention of illness, injury, or disability, the promotion of health and maintenance of the health of populations. In times of disaster, work in functional needs shelters, assisting the population.

- Provide population based services (scoliosis screening, school based flu clinics)
- Provide services to the population in all health department programs (Family Planning, Child Health, Immunizations, Sexually Transmitted Diseases, Tuberculosis).
- Provide appropriate follow up to clients based upon need and program mandates.
- Provide other duties as assigned to an expanded role RN (inventory, Pap smear follow up, etc.)

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Bachelor's degree in nursing from an accredited college or university OR Associate's degree in nursing from an accredited college or university AND current Georgia license as a RN AND any related professional work experience.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Previous Public Health experience;
- Experience in administering childhood and adult immunizations;
- Experience in case management of pregnant women.
