**JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Under general supervision, performs inspections, interviews, and technical reviews for an environmental health program in a public health department. Investigates complaints and recommends enforcement action as necessary.

- Under general to limited supervision, performs inspections, conducts interviews and technical reviews and recommends enforcement actions as needed.
- Investigates complaints and provides environmental health education and technical assistance to the general public, regulated community and officials.
- Interprets regulatory and technical issues and analytical data to document compliance with State, Federal, and local environmental health laws and regulations.
- Implements countywide programs for compliance, monitoring, enforcement and corrective action in conjunction with environmental health laws, rules and regulations.
- Serves as a compliance officer and primary liaison between public health agencies and facilities, municipalities, institutions, organizations and county and state agencies.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university which included the completion of forty (40) quarter hours (or 27 semester hours) in laboratory sciences (e.g., chemistry, biology, geology, physics, etc.) AND One year of experience at the lower level (RCP120) or position.

**Preferred Qualifications:**

- Attendance and completion of the GA EH training program.
- Completion of Standardization on the Georgia Food Code
- Completion of level I and II Certification in the On-Site Sewage Management System Program if assigned duties include Onsite Sewage
