JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:

Under general supervision, prepares media and/or regeants for use in performing routine analysis of samples. Performs routine laboratory tests and procedures under appropriate supervision. Operates and assists in maintaining lab equipment.

- Phlebotomy, performs blood draws
- Adds/posts lab results daily
- Performs tests such as Routine HIV specific labs
- Completes all requisitions for all Lab specimens going out daily with Care360 and VHN
- Scans labs, fax, file, stock and order supplies, pulls specific lab reports per nurse requests and checks off labs
- Performs other duties as assigned

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

High school diploma or GED AND One year of experience in a laboratory setting or a related area OR One year of experience required at the lower level Laboratory Tech 1 (LST030) or position equivalent.

Preferred:
