- Requires travel to the District 2 County Health Departments (13)
- Provides LARC management, insertion, and removals that include various types of IUDs and Implants
- Provides mentoring and consultations for public health nursing staff in the treatment of the District's clients' women healthcare and family planning services
- May assist Human Resources and District Administration in providing the training of new nursing personnel into the Expanded Role RN for Public Health
- Becomes proficient in understanding the State Annexes that provide family planning and Breast and Cervical Cancer services to the District's clients and assists in meeting the Annex deliverables
- Provides input into the District's adoption of the State Women's Health and Family Planning Protocols
- Works together with County and District administration to ascertain proficient public health nursing care
- May include participation in QA/QI District wide activities/training meetings that help determine training needs for the District's nursing personnel
- May include participation in Protocol Review meetings

### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

Doctorate or Master's degree in Nursing from an accredited college or university and/or other education requirements approved by the Georgia Board of Nursing AND Certification in the specialty area(s) approved by Georgia Board of Nursing AND Two years PH experience AND Georgia license as a Registered Professional Nurse AND Georgia License as a APRN AND Current certification in specialty area AND CPR certification.
