# Georgia Flu Surveillance Update: Week 01 (Ending January 08, 2022)

As of week 01, Georgia flu activity is high= 10 (on the scale of 1-13). Activity levels are based on the percent of outpatient visits in Georgia due to Influenza-like illness during this timeframe.

For the corresponding week, the percentage of outpatient visits for Influenza-like Illness was 6.0%, the number of influenza-associated death was 2; the number of Metro Area Influenza Hospitalizations was 10; and reported Influenza Outbreak was 0.
