



DISTRICT 2 PUBLIC HEALTH 2022 REPORTING ADULT ABUSE

The Adult Protective Services is the state entity charged with investigating all reports of abuse, neglect, and/or exploitation of older persons (65+) or an adult (18+) with a disability who do not reside in long-term care facilities pursuant to the Disabled Adults and Elder Persons Protection Act, O.C.G.A. §§ 30-5-1, et seq.

TYPES OF ABUSE

- Physical abuse
- Mental, emotional, or verbal abuse
- Sexual abuse
- Neglect
- Self-neglect
- Financial exploitation

Georgia law requires mandatory reporting of suspected abuse, neglect or exploitation by certain professionals who are mandated reporters. Failure for a mandated reporter to report abuse, neglect and/or exploitation of a disabled adult or elder person is punishable by a criminal misdemeanor.

Mandated reporters include among others: any person required to report child abuse as provided in subsection (c) of Code Section 19-7-5; medical personnel including physicians, interns, residents and others; dentists; pharmacists, licensed professionals; nursing personnel; employees of a public or private agency engaged in professional health-related services to elder persons or adults with disabilities; and law enforcement personnel.
