

Georgia Flu Surveillance Update: Week 19 (Ending May 14, 2022)

As of Week 19, Georgia flu activity is minimal= 2 (on the scale of 1-13). Activity levels are based on the percent of outpatient visits in Georgia due to Influenza-like illness during this timeframe.

For the corresponding week, the percentage of outpatient visits for Influenza-like Illness was 2.6%, the number of influenza-associated death was 0; the number of Metro Area Influenza Hospitalizations was 17; and reported Influenza Outbreak was 5.

Getting the flu shot is the best thing you can do to protect yourself and others.
