Georgia Flu Surveillance Update: Week 21 (Ending May 28, 2022)

As of Week 21, Georgia flu activity is minimal= 3 (on the scale of 1-13). Activity levels are based on the percent of outpatient visits in Georgia due to Influenza-like illness during this timeframe.

For the corresponding week, the percentage of outpatient visits for Influenza-like Illness was 2.7%, the number of influenza-associated death was 0; the number of Metro Area Influenza Hospitalizations was 14; and reported Influenza Outbreak was 2.
